1. EACH EXHIBITOR IS ALLOWED 2 ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED AT THE HEAD OF EACH SECTION.

2. ENTRY FEE 50C (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED). ENTRY FEES INCLUDE GST AND ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

3. ENTRIES (I.E. ENTRY FORMS AND ENTRY MONEY) MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE OFFICE OF THE SHOW SOCIETY BY MONDAY 10TH OCTOBER 2011. STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE MUST ACOMPANY ENTRY FORM IF POSTED. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

4. OFFICE HOURS ARE 9AM TO 3PM MONDAY TO FRIDAY.

5. ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE BEEN COMPLETED IN THE LAST 18 MONTHS AND NOT PREVIOUSLY ENTERED IN AN ALBURY SHOW.

6. A NOVICE EXHIBITOR IS ONE WHO HAS NOT WON A FIRST PRIZE AT ANY SHOW.

7. LAUNDERED ARTICLES, OR WORN ARTICLES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY.

8. TEACHERS IN THE CLASS OF WORK EXHIBITED, OR PERSONS WHO DO SIMILAR WORK AS A MEANS OF LIVELIHOOD, OR WHO CONDUCT A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT IN WHICH THE WORK IS SOLD, ETC., ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN NOVICE SECTIONS UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

9. MACHINE MADE ARTICLES MUST NOT HAVE ANY HANDWORK, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.
10. THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY WITHOUT ASSIGNING ANY REASON THERETO.
11. ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE TICKETS FIRMLY ATTACHED: EG: SAFETY PINS, SEWN, TAPE, **DRESSMAKER PINS NOT ALLOWED.**
12. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE THE BONA-FIDE PROPERTY, AND HOMEMADE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR.
13. EACH EXHIBIT IS ELIGIBLE TO BE ENTERED IN ONE CLASS ONLY.
14. STEWARDS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO PUT WRONGLY ENTERED EXHIBITS INTO THE CORRECT CLASSES.

18. WHILST ALL DUE CARE WILL BE TAKEN BY THE SOCIETY'S COMMITTEE. STEWARDS AND REPRESENTATIVES, NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE INCURRED BY THE SOCIETY.

24. ANY EXHIBITOR OR ASSOCIATE WHO BEHAVES OFFENSIVELY ON THE SHOWGROUND WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE GROUND AND MAY BE REFUSED FUTURE ADMISSION.
25. ANY PROTEST OR QUESTION ABOUT A COMPETITION RESULT MUST BE DIRECTED TO THE CHIEF STEWARD OF THE SECTION WITHIN 24 HOURS OF JUDGING. IF THE EXHIBITOR IS NOT SATISFIED WITH THE ANSWER OR DECISION HE OR SHE MAY LODGE A FORMAL PROTEST WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY WITHIN 12 HOURS OF THE CHIEF STEWARD'S RESPONSE. THIS FORMAL PROTEST WILL BE DEALT WITH BY THE SHOW SOCIETY'S DISPUTES COMMITTEE, WHICH WILL GIVE A FINAL DECISION WITHIN 24 HOURS. WOOLLEN ARTICLES/GARMENTS
STATE COMPETITION
THREE (3) WOOL ARTICLES/GARMENTS DISTINCT

Articles/Garments may be knitted, crocheted, sewn, felted etc and must be handcrafted (use of sewing machine is permitted. (Minimum wool content 80%) This class will not be scheduled at the Albury Annual Show 2011. However, The Chief Pavilion Steward in consultation with the appropriate Pavilion Section judges, may select three suitable individual exhibits and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular society concerned. It is the responsibility of the Group Secretary and winner to co-ordinate the transfer of the winning entry to ASC Office in Sydney for the State judging.

CONDITIONS:

1. For the purpose of this competition the following definitions apply:
 - a) Garment: an item that can be worn eg: dress, jacket, scarf, hat.
 - b) Article: a utility item that is not worn but can be used in the home e.g.: blanket; without an outfit eg: bag; for amusement eg: toy; as a decoration eg: picture etc.
2. An exhibitor in this competition may be one individual or a group of individuals or an organization.
3. All three articles/garments must have been made within twelve months of the Local Show and made by the exhibitor/s.
4. An exhibit having won at a Local Show may be exhibited (the same three articles/garments) at the Group Final. The winner of the Group Final may then be exhibited (the same three articles/garments) at the RAS State Final (Sydney Show).
5. An exhibit (the same three articles/garments) having won at the Local Show level is not eligible to enter this class at any other show until after Group Judging, when, if not being the winning entry, may then compete further.
6. An exhibit is only eligible to represent one Society at Group Level and one Group at State Level.
7. An exhibitor having won at Group level CANNOT compete further until after the Royal Show.
8. **A sample of the yarn, fabric or fibre with label must be attached to each item making up the exhibit.** If a label is not available as a handspun/felted, a handwritten label with relevant details and sample will suffice.
9. An exhibit (article/garment) not previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again.

INGREDIENTS:

250g (8oz) Sultanas	1/2 teaspoon Grated Nutmeg
250g (8oz) Currants	1/2 teaspoon Ground Cloves
125g (4oz) Chopped Mixed Peel	1/2 teaspoon Ground Ginger
90g (3oz) Chopped Red Glazed Cherries	250g (8oz) Butter
90g (3oz) Chopped Blanched Almonds	Lemon rind or half teaspoon lemon essence
1/3 cup Sherry or Brandy	25g (8oz) Soft Brown Sugar
250g (8oz) Plain Flour	4 Large Eggs
60g(2oz) Self Raising Flour	1/2 teaspoon Vanilla Essence
250g (8oz) Chopped Raisins	
1/2 teaspoon Almond Essence	

METHOD:

Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the Sherry or Brandy. Cover mixture and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together butter and sugar with essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a prepared tin no larger than 20cm (8") and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 1/2-4 hours. Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

NOTE: To ensure uniformity and depending on the size, it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces and cherries into 4-6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3-4 pieces.
