PROTESTS & PROCEDURES:

a) A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Chief Steward of the relevant section no later than ten minutes after the of judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee.

b) A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of a Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 10 pm on the day of judging. Such protest, such complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which, shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgment and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.

Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be removed from the Showground and may be refused future admission.

No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before during or after judging.

The Show Society will be the sole arbiter on any question of the eligibility of an entry.

- Animals to be on Showground by 1pm on Friday 28th October 2011 for weighing.
- All Cattle must be restrained in the following manner
 - (a) Each Animal will be securely tied up by an effective neck rope or collar and halter.
 - (b) At any other time minimum requirements males:
 - (1) Under nine months of age will be restrained by a nose grip nose ring attached to a suitable lead rope.
 - (2) Over nine months of age will be restrained by a nose ring attached to a suitable lead rope and halter with its own lead rope.
 - ◎ At any other time requirements females:
 - (1) Under nine months of age will be restrained by a halter attached to a suitable lead rope.
 - (2) Over nine months of age will be restrained by a nose grip attached to a suitable lead rope & halter with its own lead rope.
- **TRADE VEALER:** One beast, milk teeth only, live weight 250-400kg with **5-10mm** of fat at the p8site.
- **SUPERMARKET TRADE:** One beast, up to two (2) teeth, live weight of 401-480kg with **8-13mm** of fat at the p8 site.
- **HEAVY SUPERMARKET TRADE:** One beast, up to two (2) teeth, live weight of 481kg or over with **9-15mm** fat at the p8 site.

1. Judging Phase: Four animals are judged by every competitor and placing 1 to 4 recorded on separate judging cards marked "non oral" 10 min will be allowed to judge this class.
2. Oral Phase: Each competitor selected from the judge's results will have 2 min to speak on his/her placings.

3. Champion and Reserve Judges will be awarded to the top two overall point scores. Winner of judging will be asked to assist judge on Saturday.

4. Competitors should be aware that the rules only allow you to enter ONE Group Final in each type of competition as a competitor for a place representing a Group at the State Final at Sydney Royal Show. You can, however, enter and Group Final, **for practice**, in the same type of competition as one that you have previously entered as a competitor for a place as a Group Representative as long as you disclose this to the Group Final organizers at the time of entry and indicate that you are not eligible for a placing in their event.

ENTRY FEE: (per animal)- \$10.00

Hook Prizes: 1st \$30.00, 2nd \$20.00, 3rd \$10.00,

Hoof Prizes: 1st \$30.00, 2nd \$20.00, 3rd \$10.00, (unless otherwise stated)

To be judged: Saturday 28th October 2011 at 10am.

1. An entry to consist of one steer or heifer. Exhibitors are not restricted to one entry per class (Breed AND Sire must be stated on entry form.)
2. All cattle must be mouthed & NLIS tagged by exhibitor. Incorrect mouths or lack of identification will render the exhibit ineligible.
3. All cattle to be entered for both sections of the competition - Hoof & Hook will be slaughtered at an abattoir of the Societies discretion.
4. The Society undertakes to market of the carcass to the best advantage of the exhibitor, but the discretion in regards to price rests entirely with the Society. Any expenses incurred by the society by way of Government Charges will be deducted from the proceeds. The exhibitor has the right to retain the carcass. The Society will deduct 2% of proceeds for administration cost.
5. The Society undertakes to transport the cattle from the showground to the abattoirs.
6. Cattle must be polled or dehorned to within 3cm of the head. Bruising will not be taken into consideration when judging.
7. Live cattle will be judged for market suitability.
8. The committee reserves the right to alter or change the class weights and/or classification of classes.
9. All hook prizes awarded subject to chemical residue clearances correctly completed.
10. Correctly completed LPA National Vendor's Declaration must accompany entries and be given to Steward on arrival.
11. Cattle entered, which, in the opinion of the stewards fail to meet the above specifications will be rejected.
12. Exhibitors must declare breed of sire on entry form.
13. Only enter each Beast in the (Live) section, (HSW or Hook) will be done Automatically.)

TRADE VEALER: One beast, milk teeth only, hot standard carcass weight between 190kg & 220kg, with **5-10mm of fat** at the p8 site. The committee recommends a live weight of 250--400kg depending on dressing percentage.

SUPERMARKET TRADE: One beast, up to two (2) teeth, hot standard Carcass weight between 221 & 250kg with **8-13mm** of fat at the p8 site. The committee recommends a live weight of 401-480kg depending on dressing percentage.

HEAVY SUPERMARKET TRADE: One beast, up to two (2) teeth, hot standard carcass weight to go over 250kg with **9-15mm** fat at the p8 site. The committee recommends a live weight of 481kg or over depending on dressing percentage.
